Information on processing activities:

Purposes of the processing activity:

We process your partly also personal data for the initiation, implementation, and handling of contractual relationships, for the preparation of offers and invoicing as well as for contacting and information within the scope of customer service.

Legal basis of the processing activity:

The processing is necessary for the performance of a contract or a pre-contractual measure pursuant to Art. 6 (1) (b) GDPR or is necessary to safeguard our legitimate interest pursuant

to Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR and no interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject prevail.

Categories of recipients:

Internal recipients are consulting, contract management, accounting, controlling, back office. Furthermore, we use service providers (processors) to fulfil our tasks, such as IT service providers and hosting providers, and transfer data to authorities or courts within the scope of legal obligations.

Data transfer to a third country:

Since BOGE is a globally active company, it may be necessary to forward your personal data to local subsidiaries or sales partners, whose registered office may also be located outside the European Economic Area, in order to better process your request.

Prior to transfer your personal data to countries outside the European Union and the EEA, we ensure an adequate level of data protection in the country concerned (e.g. by entering into EU Standard Contract Clauses).

Additional information requirements:

Storage period of personal data:

The storage periods depend on the legal requirements, in particular § 147 Fiscal Code of Germany (AO) (10 years) and § 257 Commercial Code (HGB) (6 years). Personal data is deleted as soon as its purpose for processing is fulfilled and there is no obligation to retain it.

Rights of the data subject:

As a natural person, you have the right to request access (in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR) to the personal data concerning you from the controller, as well as the right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR), erasure (Art. 17 GDPR), and restriction of processing (Art. 18 (1) GDPR). You also have the right to object to the processing (Art. 21 GDPR) and the right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR).

If you wish to exercise your rights, please contact the data protection officer or our head office.

Right of appeal:

You have a right of appeal to the data protection supervisory authorities.

Obligation to provide personal data:

The provision of personal data about the data subject is sometimes required by law or contract or is necessary for the conclusion of a contract or for customer service and communication. The data subject is then obliged to provide the personal data.

Failure to provide this information would have the consequence that no contractual relationship could be established, or communication would be impossible.

Automated decision making:

There is no automated decision making or profiling.
